ABOUT THE POSITION

The Director of Golf reports directly to the General Manager and is a significant role within our facility including overseeing all golf course management activities and daily golf facility management responsibilities. This position requires a dynamic leader with exceptional hospitality management skills, a passion for golf, a complete understanding of customer service in hospitality, and a keen business acumen to drive revenue growth and ensure an exceptional experience for our guests.
